3. All students may apply for merit-based scholarships by filling out the Dollars for Scholars 4-page application. To be eligible for any scholarship that is **NEED-BASED**, applicants **MUST** fill out the attached **Financial Assistance Questionnaire (FAQ)**. Instructions are on the back of the FAQ.
4. Applicants must have a properly signed transcript release form on file.
5. All scholarships require the applicants to attend an accredited institution and are awarded for one year unless otherwise noted. (Colleges affiliated with Dollars for Scholars often match the Salem Education Foundation amount. See counselors for a list of participating colleges.)
6. After completing all other sections of the application, give the packet to a teacher of your choice (not a counselor) to complete the Applicant Appraisal portion. This teacher will return the packet directly to a Mrs. Arnold or Mrs. O'Connell who will complete the transcript information box.
7. Deadline for returning applications to Mrs. Arnold or Mrs. O'Connell is Friday, March 19, 2004. Please give you teacher ample time to complete the recommendation before the deadline.
